The 20 hour per week **Early Childhood Education Presenter** is a highly visible team member stationed primarily within Itty Bitty Magic City (IBMC,) McWane Science Center's early-learning exhibit space. This position is responsible for presenting hands-on, educational programming for our smallest learners both within IBMC as well as throughout the museum. This position also plays a key role in ensuring IBMC's cleaning and safety standards are met by covering greeting gate shifts (monitoring the exhibit's age requirements,) restaging loose props, cleaning high-touch areas, and modeling play behavior.

This position will primarily be scheduled Wednesday through Sunday.

## **Accountabilities and Major Duties**

- 1. Present hands-on, educational programming both within IBMC as well as throughout the museum (including but not limited to Little Labs, Animal Encounters, TinkerLabs, Tot Spot Explorers, pop-up activities, and special event programming.)
- 2. Cover shifts at the IBMC greeting gate to communicate exhibit rules to visitors as well as monitor the exhibit's age requirement and capacity limit.
- 3. Model play behavior within IBMC through frequent exhibit interpretation (including the facilitation of design challenges in the construction zone.)
- 4. Restage loose props in IBMC to ensure a consistent visitor experience.
- 5. Be proactive in the cleaning and sanitizing of loose props and high-touch areas within IBMC.
- 6. Assist in the daily opening and closing procedures of IBMC (including weekly cleaning rotations, restaging, and general office upkeep).
- 7. Cover touch tank and high cycle shifts as needed.
- 8. Assist the Early Childhood Education Department in creating a vibrant and exciting atmosphere on the exhibit floor.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

- \* Working towards a degree in Early Childhood Education, related field, or commensurate experience.
- \* Experience and enthusiasm working with children six and younger.
- \* Experience in presentation of informal, educational programs preferred.
- \* Ability to interpret and communicate educational concepts for young children preferred.
- \* Ability to engage with both children and adults in an enthusiastic, friendly, outgoing, and professional manner.
- \* Comfort in handling small animals (reptiles and mammals) preferred.
- \* Must be able and willing to work weekends, evenings, and holidays.

## **Minimum Physical Qualifications**

\* Sit/stand for extended periods of time without being able to leave the work area; including walking, kneeling, crawling and playing.

- \* Lift objects frequently in performing the work (10-20 lbs.)
- \* Pull or push objects on a regular basis (50 lbs.).
- \* Grasp object utilizing the fingers.
- \* Reach for objects above the head or below the waist.
- \* Stoop or crouch by bending at the waist or by bending legs.
- \* Hearing and visual acuity.

\* Exposure to chemicals, fumes and vapors that could potentially affect the health of the employee.
